

Disney Entertainment Television(DET) Health & Safety Guidelines

California Productions

Face Coverings:

Performers and Crew must wear face coverings when:

- Required by orders from California Department of Public Health
- During outbreaks
- As a close contact or positive case (see bubbles below and right)

Health Screening:

- If you are exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms, do not report to the workplace and inform your immediate supervisor
- If you begin exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms at the workplace, inform your immediate supervisor and leave the workplace

Close Contacts:

If you were exposed to COVID-19:

- Wear a well-fitted face covering around others for a total of 10 days from exposure to a positive case
- Performers should wear a face covering when they are not performing or having hair and makeup applied
- Watch for symptoms and if you develop symptoms, isolate immediately and contact your immediate supervisor
- Antigen test will be given to close contacts (if requested) to be taken 3-5 days after work-related exposure to a positive case
 - If you test negative, continue wearing a face covering through Day 10
 - If positive, follow positive case guidance (see bubble to right)

Positive Cases:

If you test positive for COVID-19, immediately submit [Positive Case Reporting Form](#) to the DET Contact Tracers

- If you test positive and ARE experiencing unexplained COVID-19 symptoms:
 - Stay at home
 - Isolation can end once symptoms are no longer present or are mild and improving; AND fever has been resolved for 24-hours (without the use of fever-reducing medication)
 - Wear a well-fitted face covering around others for 10 days from onset of symptoms, especially in indoor settings. May remove face covering before Day 10 if you have two sequential negative tests at least one day apart.
- If you test positive and ARE NOT experiencing COVID-19 symptoms:
 - **Crew** - may continue working, but must wear a face covering (for 10 days from positive test)
 - **Performers** – to work unmasked, you must wait to return until you have two sequential negative tests at least 24 hours apart. The first test must be taken at least 1 day after the initial positive result.
