# Disney Entertainment Television(DET) Health & Safety Guidelines U.S Productions (outside California and NYC)

## Face Coverings:

Performers and Crew should wear face coverings:

- When required by orders from CDC or local health department
- When returning to work after having COVID-19 until 5 days have passed since ending isolation
- For up to 10 days after close contact with a positive case

## **Health Screening:**

- If you are exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms, do not report to the workplace and inform your immediate supervisor
- If you begin exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms at the workplace, inform your immediate supervisor and leave the workplace

## Close Contacts:

If you were exposed to COVID-19:

- If you are asymptomatic, no quarantine is necessary. It is recommended you wear a
  face covering for up to 10 days from last exposure with positive case. Performers
  should wear a face covering when they are not performing or having hair and
  makeup applied.
- If you are symptomatic, do not report to work and take a COVID-19 test as soon as possible
  - If positive, follow positive case protocol
  - If negative, please consider staying home from work and retesting in 1-2 days. Testing can be repeated every 1-2 days if symptoms persist.

### **Positive Cases:**

If you test positive for COVID-19:

- Immediately submit Positive Case Reporting Form to the DET Contact Tracers
- Stay home and away from others if you have symptoms. If you have no symptoms, you may continue to work and should follow added precautions listed below for next 5 days. If symptoms develop, follow the guidelines for testing positive with symptoms.
- Isolation can end when, for at least 24 hours, your symptoms are getting better overall AND you have not had a fever (and are not using fever-reducing medicine)

### **Recommended Added Precautions:**

- Once you end isolation, it is recommended to take added precautions over the next 5 days which includes wearing a face covering
- Refer to the <u>CDC</u> for recommended additional precautions
