### NEW & YOUNG WORKER ORIENTATION SCRIPT FOR CAST/BACKGROUND OR OTHER ON-SET WORKER

This orientation script should be used daily to brief workers on the hazards, emergency procedures, and first aid procedures each day.

# **GENERAL SAFETY**

You have the right to refuse unsafe work. If you believe that performing a job or task puts you or someone else at risk, you must not perform the job or task. You must immediately report unsafe conditions to an AD.

If you see something unsafe, please inform an AD, or call the Disney Safety Hotline, located on Safety Boards.

Any acts of violence or threatened acts of violence will not be tolerated. If you are affected threatened or harassed, you must notify your supervisor immediately. All such reports will be fully investigated.

Please stay in designated areas of the set, basecamp or location. Do not leave the assigned location unless you have received permission from ADs or Production.

# EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

### POINT OUT FIRE EXIT(S) LOCATIONS

Fire lanes are to be kept clear at all times. Do not block exit doors or walkways.

### POINT OUT MUSTER STATION LOCATION

In case of emergency, make your way to the Muster Station. Report to an AD or Wrangler that you are clear from the building

## NAME FIRST AID ATTENDANT & POINT OUT THEIR LOCATION

Report ALL injuries to them.

#### NAME ANY SAFETY HAZARDS APPLICABLE FOR THE DAY Refer to call-sheet safety memos for more info

#### **EVERYDAY HAZARDS**

Cables / Tripping Hazards

Stay away from overhead work or Risk of Falling Objects

## **OTHER HAZARDS**

Animals on Set

Atmosphere/ Smoke (Note that Smoke/Atmos liquid is non-toxic/water-based/odourless)

Edged & Piercing Props

Food Handling

Inclement or Severe Weather (Hot or Cold)

Infant or Child Actors/Background on Set

**Open Flames / Candles** 

Pyrotechnics / Other Special Effects

Rain / Wet down / Slick Surfaces

Stunts
